SUMMER OUTDOOR SERIES

We plan to host a series of outdoor activities on Forterra-connected properties to highlight our conservation work. Potential examples include a guided plant walk for families, a bicycle tour of the Olympic peninsula, and berry picking at a local farm.

RESEARCH

Forterra partners with other organizations to participate in research that benefits conservation in Washington. Sponsorship recognition for research could include your logo on maps produced from the research, on the websites where the research is displayed, and promotion through social media.

Produce the next in the series of the Forterra-produced podcast, *Rooted:* Where We Stand, which explored humans and nature as inseparable. Next topics may include exploring the complexities around environmental conservation and climate justice.

Recognition could include inepisode spoken ads, social media promotion, and an event for your staff and podcast host.

Forterra welcomes in-kind services, including food, beverage, raffle items, or event space donations.

LUNCH & LEARNS

Forterra can speak to your company on an aspect of our work that your team is particularly interested in, or a part of our work that aligns with your industry. These talks are often about 30 minutes, can be tailored to your preferred format, and can include time for questions.

Forterra plants and maintains ECC trees for carbon sequestration throughout Western Washington. Together with corporate and nonprofit partners, field partners, and hundreds of volunteers, we have planted thousands of native trees around the Puget Sound, which will improve our region's resiliency against climate change.


